



Summer Camp Counselor & Junior Counselor and C.I.T. Opportunities

Creative Cauldron, Inc. is seeking candidates for our Counselor (must be at least 18 years old), Junior Counselor (must be at least 15 years old) and Counselor-in-training (must be at least 14 years old) positions for the 2016 summer *Arts Adventure Camp* program. *Arts Adventure Camp* is a unique summer day camp that uses a theme-based approach to explore the performing and visual arts. The camp is led by a group of experienced theater artists, dancers and visual artists. Associate Producers and Junior Producers play a major role in the success of each camp through their mentoring a group of 12-14 children. They provide support and assistance to the professional staff as they work with the children developing original performances and works of art.

Arts Adventure Camps use nature, folklore and mythology to nurture a fun and engaging learning community. In addition to daily activities in drama, music, dance and visual arts, campers enjoy afternoon swims at a local pool two to three times per week.

There are five camp sessions offered:

<i>Agents of Imagination (Spring Break)</i>	April 15 - 19
<i>Arts Adventure Sampler</i>	June 24 – July 3 (No Camp July 4)
<i>Festival of Fools</i>	July 8 – July 26
<i>Magic is Alive: Goddess Tales</i>	July 29 – August 16
<i>Musical Theater Camp</i>	August 19 - 30

Camp Hours are 9:00 am to 3:30 pm., with before care beginning at 8:00 am and after care extending to 5:30 pm. Camp counselors will be needed for all four sessions, although more positions will be available for August camps.

Applicants should have prior experience in the performing arts and experience mentoring and working with younger children. The ideal applicant will also have a keen interest in outdoor recreation and exploration of the natural world. Counselors will receive an hourly pay, based on prior employment experience. Counselors-in-training will receive a small stipend.
